

- Snow plow operators will stay a safe distance away from garage doors, patio doors etc. Determination of a safe distance is at the discretion of the plow operator.
- Snow plow operators will not clear walkways to the home.
- Above all be patient. Be prepared to change or cancel appointments during inclement weather. Not everyone can be first to have their driveways cleared.

The Senior/Disabled Snow Plow Program is limited to the first 400 applicants. Others will be placed on a waiting list. No applications will be accepted past the deadline.

ELIGIBILITY

The Senior/Disabled Snow Plow Program is limited to:

1. Seniors age 62 and older, who own & reside at the property to be plowed.
2. Disabled adults meeting the federal government criteria. (Must show proof)
3. Any Bedford Heights resident whose military spouse has been deployed for active military duty. (Must show proof)



INELIGIBILITY

Anyone having an able-bodied person that does not meet the eligibility requirement (See ELIGIBILITY)

If the status of the applicant changes (i.e. sale of residence, home becomes vacant, able bodied individuals move into the home, etc.)

During the duration of the program, the resident is obligated to report any changes in the status that would otherwise make them ineligible.

Under penalty of law, falsification of any information for the purpose of receiving this service shall result in removal of this service and possible restitution for services rendered.

PROGRAM RULES

This is a basic snow removal service. Snow will be removed from driveways only:

- When accumulation of snow reaches approximately three inches (3") as determined by the Director of Public Works.
- Driveways will not be cleared more than once in a 24-hour period unless authorized by the Director of the Public Works Department.
- Snow removal service only will apply to actual snow fall. Snow removal vehicles will not be dispatched to remove drifting or windblown snow.
- Snow plow operators will remove snow up to the rear of the last vehicle left in the driveway. In order to have your driveway completely cleared, vehicles should be parked in the garage or removed from driveway.
- Snow plow operators are not required to inform the homeowner of their arrival to remove the snow.
